## Glen Ridge Swim Club: Pool Rules at a Glance

## Pool Safety

- **Lifeguards have full authority over pool safety.** Their decisions must be followed at all times, including when to close areas or enforce rules.
- Running, rough play, pushing, and causing disturbances are not permitted. Safe behavior is expected at all times on the pool deck and in the water.
- Only swimmers who have passed the required swim test may use the diving area or adult pool. Approved swim badges or wristbands must be worn when required.
- Children under 13 must be accompanied by a responsible person age 16 or older. Children age 13 who have passed the swim test may attend unaccompanied with completed permission and emergency forms.
- Individuals with open wounds, illnesses, or other contagious conditions may not enter the pool. Children who are not toilet trained are not permitted in the main pool.
  Swim diapers must be worn in the wading pool, and diaper changes must occur in designated areas.

## Pool Etiquette

- Glass containers, sharp objects, and water guns are not allowed. Other toys and flotation devices may only be used with staff permission.
- **Deck chairs may not be reserved.** Chairs may not be saved by placing towels, bags, or other personal belongings on them.
- Food and drinks are permitted only in designated areas. Radios and other personal devices must be used at a volume that does not disturb others. Alcohol, smoking, vaping, or cigars are not allowed on pool grounds.
- All members must sign in upon arrival. Appropriate swimwear is required. Respectful behavior is expected from all members and guests at all times.

## Fees

- The guest fee is \$8.00 per person. A maximum of 5 guests is allowed per day, unless part of a single household. Groups of 6 or more must be scheduled in advance.
- Pool access is limited to members in good standing and their immediate families. The club is not responsible for lost or damaged personal property.
